Edward Rom, founder and CEO of EFR Travel Group, shares his memories of a fabulous cruise with Regent Seven Seas

aving sailed on many other luxury cruise lines, l eagerly anticipated boarding the Regent Seven Seas Grandeur® for the first time. I was excited to experience Regent Seven Seas® as a brand, and to enjoy their modern take on cruising.

We embarked at around midday; although this was too early to access our suite, we were made incredibly welcome by all the crew and were able to start exploring the ship straight away. We spent the rest of the afternoon relaxing on the spacious pool deck. It offered plenty of room for all guests to spread out comfortably, with ample options for both sun and shade, making it easy for everyone to find their ideal spot. Drinks were readily available, and our lunch by the pool ws accompanied by exceptional service including the service. We found ourselves returning to the pool deck often, thoroughly impressed by the experience.

With great expectations, we ventured down to our Penthouse Suite on Deck 9 - one of 10 - later that afternoon. We fell in love

incredibly well-appointed, with a practical and appealing layout and design. The bed was centrally positioned offering a fantastic sea, and there was plenty of room on either side to walk around. The closet was so spacious, I joked that I nearly lost my wife in there; perfect if you're travelling with lots sized tub and walk in shower; the divinely scented toiletries were by Bulgari. The Suite also had plenty of room to sit and relax, whether we wanted to lounge on our sofa and watch TV, or sit by the mirror at the desk to do our hair (more my wife than me, in that instance...).

One of our favourite aspects of the cruise was the on-board restaurants. We tried them all, and one thing that was really striking about them was their design; each one looked very different and was beautifully crafted, with Compass Rose a particular highlight. The ambiance, whether during the day or night, was superb, the food magnificent, and the service second to none. Breakfast could be taken in either Compass Rose, the main dining room, or La Veranda, which offered a buffet with a wide





selection of dishes. For a quick coffee on the go, the casual Coffee Connection was a perfect choice. For dinner, Compass Rose served a wide varied menu of modern cuisine, while Pacific Rim offered a contemporary twist to Asian flavours. Chartreuse was just sublime for an amazing French fine dining experience, Prime 7 was the place for wonderful steak, and Sette Mari at La Veranda was just divine for that taste of Italy.

For lunch we often dined at the Pool Grill and La Veranda, which offered a fantastic option for those seeking a quiet spot, with amazing seating on an outside deck where we could enjoy the fabulous food with sea views. Overall the choice of dining is so varied that on a seven day cruise you would never be at risk of eating the same thing twice. There was a very good choice of wine to suit all tastes of wine, with no compromise on quality. The entertainment was just as exceptional - extremely varied and highly professional. The productions, the singers and the actors were as good as we have experienced on any cruise of this kind of level.

Overall, our experience, like the seas, was seven star. The service, the food, and the quality of the ship were magnificent and we couldn't find fault with a single thing. We're already looking forward to setting sail on the Grandeur again!"






